**Rule Committee of the Personal Injury Commission
RESOLUTION #3 of 2026
Pursuant to section 19(7) of the Personal Injury Commission Act 2020**

On 9 March 2026, the Rule Committee of the Personal Injury Commission of New South Wales (**Committee**) resolved by 10 members voting in favour and 1 member abstaining (2 members absent) as follows:

1. To instruct the Parliamentary Counsel's Office to create rules regarding the new section 58A of the *Personal Injury Commission Act 2020* (PIC Act), which are to address the following:
 - a. An application for a relevant order under section 58A of the PIC Act must be made in writing to the President.
 - b. An application can be made at any stage during or after the proceedings.
 - c. An application must be served on all parties to the proceedings. Any response to the application is to be served within three working days.
 - d. Consideration will be given to whether the parties consent to the order being made.
 - e. A decision to grant or refuse to make a relevant order shall be supported by reasons in accordance with the PIC Rules and the Commission's Procedural Directions.

The President voted for the resolution set out above.
